<u>News from the wider Catholic Church in England and Wales</u> – Pope Francis has recently appointed the Rt. Rev. Philip Moger (currently an auxiliary bishop in the Archdiocese of Southwark) to be the new Bishop of Plymouth. The Pope has also merged the Archdiocese of Cardiff and the neighbouring Diocese of Menevia to form one diocese covering the whole of South Wales and Herefordshire.

Romanian Orthodox Community - Some weeks ago Father Marcus laid before parishioners in consultation the possibility of helping the small Romanian Orthodox community in the Bracknell area by allowing them to use our Church of the Immaculate Conception for worship. Thank you to all who contributed a view. While some people expressed understandable concerns about the practicalities of this, the broad response from parishioners was positive. In light of this Father Marcus laid the possibility before Bishop Philip for consideration and he has now given permission for us to proceed. The arrangement will be subject to a Memorandum of Understanding and a contract which clearly set out the terms of the arrangement and specifies the financial offering the Orthodox community will make to the parish for use of our premises and amenities. The situation will be kept under regular review. The Orthodox request use of our church after our own 9.00am Mass on the third Sunday of each month. They also wish to use it on Friday evenings for a devotional service to Our Lady and for occasional services such as weddings and baptisms. All of these arrangements will be dependent upon the activities and needs of our own parish community, which will always have priority. As with any new initiative there are bound to be things which will need fine-tuning as we discover the practicalities. It is good that we can make this ecumenical gesture of Christian love and friendship to members of another Church which in so many ways is so close to us in faith.

<u>**Tea Party</u>** – Many thanks to our Social Committee and their team of helpers who worked so hard at organising and running the Tea Party last Sunday afternoon. It was very well attended by parishioners of all ages and everybody seemed to enjoy the occasion very much.</u>

<u>Mass Count</u> – Every Autumn parishes are required to count on four consecutive weekends the number of those present at Mass. From this it is possible to work out an average Mass attendance for the parish. The first of this year's counts will be the weekend of 21/22 September.
