Epiphany House Blessing - It is a Catholic custom, widely observed in Central Europe, to ask for God's blessing upon our homes for the coming year by writing with chalk, blessed in the church for this purpose at Epiphany, the symbol 20 + C + M + B + 25 on the lintel above the main door of the house. The letters C M B have two meanings. They are the initials of the names traditionally given to the Three Wise Men (Caspar, Melchior and Balthasar) and also stand for the Latin words *Christus mansionem bendicat*, meaning *May Christ bless this house*. The other symbols represent the cross of Christ and the numbers of the year. While doing this the following prayer is said:

The Three Wise Men

- C Caspar,
- M Melchior,
- B and Balthasar, followed the star of God's Son
- 20 two thousand
- 25 and twenty-five years ago.
- ++ May Christ bless our home
- ++ and remain with us through the new year.

Visit, O blessed Lord, this house with the gladness of your presence. Bless all who live or visit here with the gift of your love, and grant that we may manifest your love to each other and to all whose lives we touch. May we grow in grace, and in knowledge and love of you. Guide, comfort, and strengthen us in your peace, O Lord Jesus Christ, now and forever. Amen.

The chalk will be blessed during Mass this weekend and made available for people to take home with them.
